We have had an influx of new neighbours moving into Linley Point. Please make them welcome and, more importantly, if they live next door or opposite exchange phone numbers and advise each other if going away and ask to clear junk mail.

This has proved needed when alarms have been activated and the owners could not be contacted. Also noticed is some of us, even when we have alarms or locked doors/windows, don't activate or lock them for short trips up the street. People wanting to enter your home are normally watching and know when you leave. Don't give them an easy entry...

Keep up your awareness of happenings around you. Report anyone or anything suspicious immediately to Chatswood police who will respond quickly and to me who can quickly alert everyone. It is our best defence against crime in our community. Keep up the good work...

I mentioned council had advised me of their intention to upgrade some of the badly needed repair to streets up here. These have been delayed due to lack of funds. An update will follow when another timetable has been advised.
