DO NOT

- Leave spare keys outside your home
- Attach your name and address to your keys
- Leave notes on the front door advising visitors that you are absent
- When away, do not leave a message on your answering machine advising callers of your absence
- Keep large amounts of cash at home

These are the most common facts reported to police after a house has been invaded.
